

Holiday from Home: Write and Send a Postcard

TIP: You don't need to print this sheet, you could simply get a piece of paper or card and copy the bits you like!

EQUIPMENT

- This template printed on A4 card **OR** a plain piece of A4 card if you are designing your own.
- Scissors, glue and decorating materials (e.g. stickers, pens, colouring pencils).
- Postage stamp if you would like to send it through the post.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Print & cut out the template and any pieces you want to use below.
- 2 Draw on the front of your postcard. You can draw what you have been doing on your holiday from home or something completely different!
- 3 On the back, write your message and the address of your lucky recipient.
- 4 Fold the card and glue the front and back sides together. Your postcard is now ready to be sent. If you want to post it don't forget the stamp!
